Course Description:

This course will equip the student with the skills required of an Emergency Medical Technician to provide basic care to individuals in a variety of health care settings. It consists of one 13 week module in class plus 24 hours required clinical rotation during the thirteen weeks for a total of 180 hours during the evening with clinicals scheduled day or evening.

Course Objectives:

- Identify the role of an emergency medical technician care of the sick and injured.
- Demonstrate the ability to interact and communicate with hospital & ambulance staff, peers, instructors and staff.
- Provide a safe environment, being alert for potential hazards and taking appropriate measures when a hazard is identified.
- Practice and participate infection control measures to help prevent or control the spread of infections.
- Develop skills necessary for health care provider applications.
- Observe procedures common in the health care environment and apply knowledge.
- Use equipment and supplies appropriately.
- Develop observation skills, including subjective data and objective observations rather than judgments.
- Demonstrate correct style of charting for the facility to include legibility, clarity, conciseness, using appropriate medical terminology and abbreviations. Correct errors in a legally acceptable manner.
